- As of August, 2024 **Revenue** (aka giving) was \$493,883 and **Expenses** were \$514,221, which resulted in a Year To Date (YTD) loss of **\$20,338**.
- Compared to what was budgeted for 2024, YTD **Revenue** is lower by **\$31,550**, which is partially offset by lower **Expenses** of \$14,010. This results in the church being behind budget by **\$17,540** as of the end of August.
- Compared to 2023, YTD **Revenue** is behind by **\$25,567**, which is partially offset by lower **Expenses** of \$42,617, resulting in the church being ahead of 2023 by \$17,051 as of the end of August.
