FEBRUARY FINANCIAL REPORT

2025 Revenue (aka giving) was \$164,039 and Expenses were \$122,505, which resulted in a Year To Date (YTD) surplus of \$41,534

Compared to what was budgeted for 2025, Revenue was favorable by \$9,307 and Expenses were favorable by \$11,262. This results in the church being better than budget by \$20,568 at the end of February.

Compared to February 2024, YTD Revenue was unfavorable by (\$2,320), and Expenses were favorable by \$25,212, resulting in the church finishing better than 2024 by \$23,191

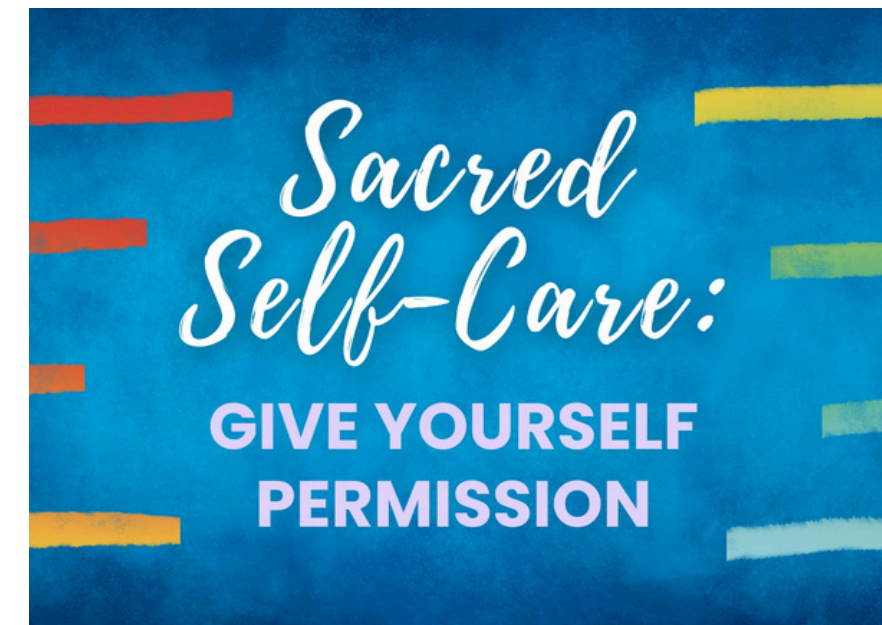
