YEAR END FINANCIAL UPDATE

–2025 Revenue (including giving) was \$772,174 and Expenses were \$741,242, which resulted in a Year To Date (YTD) surplus of \$30,932.
–Compared to what was budgeted for 2025, Revenue was favorable by \$17,768 and Expenses were favorable by \$41,674. This results in the church being better than budget by \$59,442 at the end of 2025.
–Compared to 2024, Revenue was favorable by \$39,145, and Expenses were favorable by \$1,471, resulting in the church finishing better than 2024 by \$40,617.
