### MAY FINANCIAL STATEMENT

2026 Revenue (including giving) is \$350,003 and Expenses are \$305,787, resulting in a Year To Date (YTD) surplus of \$44,216.

Compared to what is budgeted for 2026, Revenue is unfavorable by \$13,795 and Expenses are favorable by \$41,588. This results in the church being better than budget by \$27,793 at the end of May 2026.

Compared to last year, Revenue is unfavorable by \$19,743, and Expenses are favorable by \$3,436, resulting in the church being worse than May 2025 by \$16,307.
