2026 Revenue (including giving) is \$143,117 and Expenses are \$119,668, resulting in a Year To Date (YTD) surplus of \$23,449.

Compared to what is budgeted for 2026, Revenue is unfavorable by \$20,501 and Expenses are favorable by \$23,005. This results in the church being better than budget by \$2,504 at the end of February 2026.

Compared to last year, Revenue is unfavorable by \$20,922, and Expenses are favorable by \$2,837, resulting in the church being worse than February 2025 by \$18,085.


