2026 Revenue (including giving) is \$434,827 and Expenses are \$428,402, resulting in a Year To Date (YTD) surplus of \$6,426. Compared to what is budgeted for 2026, Revenue is unfavorable by \$14,443 and Expenses are favorable by \$38,212. This results in the church being better than budget by \$23,770 at the end of July 2026. Compared to last year, Revenue is unfavorable by \$20,288, and Expenses are unfavorable by \$1,152, resulting in the church being worse than July 2025 by \$21,440.
