ORCHARD FINANCIAL REPORT

Revenue, Expense and Net Income

- As of September, 2024 Revenue (aka Giving) was \$536,842 and Expenses were \$566,356, which resulted in a Year To Date (YTD) loss of \$29,514.
- Compared to what was budgeted for 2024, YTD Revenue is lower by \$29,421, which is partially offset by lower Expenses of \$22,443. This results in the church being behind budget by \$6,978 as of the end of September.
- Compared to 2023, YTD Revenue is behind by \$34,612, which is partially offset by lower Expenses of \$56,033, resulting in the church being ahead of 2023 by \$21,421 as of the end of September.
